## Attention Dog Owners!!!



### ACHA Landscaping Corner

#### Dear Homeowners:

Maintaining your yard not only makes the neighborhood nice for all to enjoy, but it adds value to your property. Also, part of the Association By-Laws require homeowners to maintain their yard. Following are a few tips to help make it easier to keep your yard nice:

### Easy Lawn Care Tips

Get a greener, healthier lawn with less work! From the Family HandyMan Magazine

#### Tip 1: Apply a preemergence herbicide to stop crabgrass and Dandilions

Stop crabgrass by spreading a preemergence herbicide after your second or third mowing.

#### Tip 2: Water less often – but for longer periods of time

Deep, infrequent watering during hot, dry weather is important to maintain a healthy lawn. Deep watering encourages the turf to develop a deeper, more extensive root system. Conversely, frequent, shallow watering encourages a shallow root system. A shallow root system means a lawn is under drought stress when the top inch of soil dries out.

#### Tip 3: Set you mower blade at the right height to control weeds and look healthy

Measure the cutting height to match the ideal length for the type of grass in your yard – usually 2.5 – 3.0 inches. A dull blade will push/pull grass rather than cut it. Make sure your blade is sharp (call a local hardware store).

#### Tip 4: Fertilize!!

If you want the best lawn in town, fertilize four times a year. Spread out evenly during the growing season – and make sure you don't miss the fall fertilizing – it is the most important one! Ask an expert for which products to use during each time of the season.



Tip 5: Mulch planting beds for less weeding and watering

A 4-in. layer of mulch will eliminate most weeds (and the need for backbreaking pulling!)
